The Sydney Figure Skating Club aims to host a quality event providing the best available practice times for competitors.

The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions.

- from New Zealand, Philippines and Singapore may be submitted by Affiliated Clubs in those countries following notification (as applicable) to their National Federations, in accordance with ISU Rule 107.12.
- **MUST** be on the applicable entry form and be accompanied by the completed Planned Program Content Sheet (PPC) for all programs.

No responsibility will be taken by SFSC for entries not delivered or mailed to one of the above destinations.

Withdrawals: Refund – only with medical certificate – a 10% deduction from the entry fee before the draw and no refund available after the draw.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the first three placegetters in each event. The Perpetual Trophies will be retained by the Sydney Figure Skating Club and will be engraved with the winner's name and displayed at Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink.

Music: Music **MUST** be on tape/CD. All tapes/CDs **MUST** be clearly marked with the competitor's name, program, event and music time. The official competition tape/CD must be submitted at the Registration Desk at the time of registration. Tapes/CDs **MUST** have one piece of music per tape/CD. Please have a spare copy at the rink during the event in case it is needed. Music may be retrieved from the Registration Desk after the event.

Technical Requirements (Updated): In accordance with ISA Regulations published on www.isa.org.au and ISU Regulations & applicable ISU Communications published on www.isu.org.

- Junior & Senior Singles (Short Program & Free Skating): ISU Rules 501, 510 (Junior SP Group C 2010/2011), 520, ISA Rules 310, 320, 520-539 (as applicable).
- Pre-Primary Pairs (Free Skating): ISA Rules 305, 321 & 601.
- Primary & Novice Pairs (Short Program & Free Skating): ISA Rules 305, 313, 321 & 541-546 (as applicable).
- Junior & Senior Pairs (Short Program & Free Skating): ISU Rules 501, 513 (Junior or Senior SP Group B 2010/2011), 521, ISA Rules 313, 321, ISA Rules 547-552 (as applicable).
- Pre-Primary Dance (Compulsory & Original Dance): ISA Rule 337 – CD Group 2, #2 Foxtrot, ISA Rule 338 – OD Group 2, March (52-62 measures/minute, 112-124 beats/minute), ISA Rule 601.
- Primary Dance (Compulsory & Free Dance): ISA Rule 337 – CD Group 2, #2 Foxtrot, ISA Rule 339 – FD, ISA Rules 556-558 (as applicable).
- Novice Dance (Compulsory & Free Dance): ISA Rule 337 – CD Group 2, #24 Blues, ISA Rule 339 FD, ISA Rule 560-563 (as applicable).
- Junior Dance (Compulsory & Free Dance): ISU Rules 608 & 610 plus ISU Communication 1567 (& subsequent Communications) – CD #14 Quickstep, ISA Rules 565 – 568 (as applicable).
- Senior Dance (Compulsory & Free Dance): ISU Rules 608 & 610 plus ISU Communication 1567 (& subsequent communications) – CD #10 Ravensburger Waltz, ISA Rules 570 – 573 (as applicable).

Please Note: (1) Changes to requirements and elements as adopted at the 2010 ISA AGM are applicable immediately and will be posted on the ISA website as soon as possible. (2) Changes to maximum program duration for ISA Primary, Intermediate & Novice Short Programs, as adopted at the 2010 ISA AGM, will not be implemented until 1 January, 2011.

Registration: The official registration desk will be located at the main entrance. Competitors **must check** in **1 hour** before the event.

Draws: The opening draw will be conducted at Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink at 5:30pm on Friday 21 May 2010. Subsequent draws will be conducted following the conclusion of the applicable event.

Judges: Each State association of ISA, together with the NZ Ice Skating Association Inc, the Philippine Skating Union and the Singapore Ice Skating Association, is invited to nominate a Judge or Judges for any of the scheduled events, subject to their possessing the required qualifications for that level of judging. These nominations must be advised to the Sydney Figure Skating Club, email support@sydney-fsc.com before the closing date.

Photography: An official photographer will be taking photos at the 2010 Hollins Trophy. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is allowed in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event.

Video Recording: An official DVD will be available for purchase. Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event. A video pass will be issued at no charge. Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area. **NO VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS IS ALLOWED.**
