### **ANNOUNCEMENT**

**ORGANISING BODY:** Iceworld Figure Skating Club Inc., affiliated to the ISQ.

**DESCRIPTION:** Winter Sun is an annual Interstate Competition for Men and Ladies from Preliminary to Senior and also including Pairs & Dance and Aussie Skate Free Skate Levels 1, 2, 3 & 4 conducted in accordance with the rules of I.S.A.

**VENUE:** Iceworld Olympic Ice Rink, 1179 Beaudesert Road, ACACIA RIDGE Qld, 4110.

**ICE SURFACE:** The dimensions of the ice surface are 60m x 26m.

**DIVISIONS:**

**Singles:** A/Skate Free Skate 1, A/Skate Free Skate 2, A/Skate Free Skate 3, A/Skate Free Skate 4, Preliminary, Elementary, Pre-Primary, Primary, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Senior (Ladies and Men)

**Pairs:** Pre-Primary, Primary, Novice, Junior and Senior

**Ice Dance:** Elementary, Pre-Primary, Primary, Novice, Junior and Senior

"**Le Patinage Artistique**", "**Solo Dance**" and "**Theatre on Ice**" will be held in conjunction with Winter Sun, with divisions for a wide range of skaters including Skate School and Adults. (Refer to the companion announcements.)

**DATES:** **Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July to Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2010**

**TIMES:** Starting times will be advised approximately 14 days prior to the events.

**DRAW:** Draws for initial Start Order will take place on **Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2010 at 5.00PM** at the rink.

**ENTRIES:** **Entries must be submitted through State Associations** and will be accepted by the Competition Convenor of the I.F.S.C. until the closing date. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Convenor but will run the risk of not being accepted & will incur a penalty of double the entry fee. **No entries** will be accepted after the Draw. The I.F.S.C. reserves the right to cancel a division if 2 or less entries are received for that division.

**THE ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES.**

**NOTE: Entry Fee includes all Official Practices (except Aussie Skate).**

***Closing date for entries: Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2010***

### **ENTRY FEES:**

Aussie Skate Free Skate Levels 1, 2, 3 & 4 \$ 60.00

*The following fees include all official practices:*

Singles:

Preliminary, Elementary & Pre-Primary \$ 110.00

Primary - Senior \$ 150.00

Pairs (per pair) \$ 190.00

Dance (per couple) \$ 190.00

Entry fees provide all singles, pair and dance competitors and one chaperone each with free admission to all competition and official practice sessions.

**Withdrawals:** Refund – only with medical certificate – a 10% deduction from the entry fee before the draw and no refunds for withdrawal after the draw.

### **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS<sup>1</sup>**

#### **Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary test:**

- **must be financial members of their State Association and an affiliated Club; the memberships must be valid during the full competition period.**

#### **Skaters who have NOT passed the ISA Preliminary test:**

- ***Queensland Skaters:* must be financial members of a Club affiliated with the ISQ; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.**
- ***Interstate Skaters who haven't passed Preliminary:* as required by your state organisation; the membership(s) must be valid during the full competition period.**

#### **Overseas entrants:**

- **must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organisation; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.**

### **PRACTICES:**

Practice times will be advised approximately 14 days prior to the competition.

NOTE: Official practices will not be provided for Aussie Skate divisions.

## WINTER SUN 2010

### **MUSIC:**

#### **Music must:**

- be provided on Compact Disc,
- contain only one track,
- be marked with:
  - competitor's name,
  - division (e.g. Junior Ladies)
  - program description (e.g. "Short Program")
  - exact running time of the music (not skating time).

### **JUDGES:**

Each State or Club is invited to nominate a judge or judges for one or all of the competitions. It would be appreciated if these nominations could be advised at the same time as entries are submitted, or as soon as possible thereafter.

All judges for Winter Sun must have authorised membership of their State association.

### **MARKING:**

Closed Marking: The 6.0 System will be used for Aussie Skate Levels

Closed Marking: IJS System for Preliminary to Senior Levels.

### **DETERMINATION OF RESULTS:**

The ISU Judging System will be used for Singles divisions from Preliminary upwards. Closed marking will be used for Aussie Skate divisions, using the 6.0 system.

### **TROPHIES:**

Trophies will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each division.

### **THE DAVE BUCHANAN MEMORIAL TROPHY:**

This Perpetual Trophy will be awarded for an outstanding performance of either the short or free skate program in the Primary – Senior Singles Divisions (Queensland competitors only).

The Trophy will be retained by IFSC Inc. and will be engraved with the winner's name and year.
